



## General Information

The Building Officials' Association of Georgia is an organization having voluntary membership consisting of Building and Code Officials employed by the State of Georgia and its municipalities, together with associate members from branches of government service, professional associations, and the building industry. It was formed in 1958 and incorporated in April 1994.

### Objectives:

1. To promote uniform building regulations throughout the State of Georgia.
2. To promote the uniform interpretation of the building code throughout the State of Georgia.
3. To promote close cooperation between code officials and the building industry, government, and the public.
4. To promote a high standard of inspection services within the State of Georgia.
5. To promote education and certification of code officials in the State of Georgia.

### Communication:

The Association holds a Conference and Annual Business Meeting in April or May of each year. Technical papers, workshops and discussions provide an instructive and interesting program. Reports of these meetings are distributed to all members through the Association's Quarterly publication. The Association is divided into 9 chapters, and chapter members are encouraged to meet together as frequently as possible for mutual benefit. At present, regular meetings are held by CGIA, EGIA, GSIA, MAIA, MGIA, MWGIA, NGCOA, SWGIA, and WGIA chapters.
